Moth

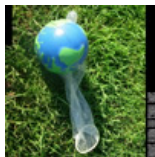

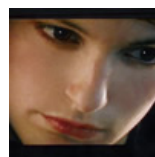

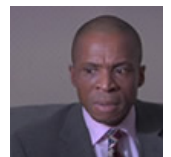


Jehovah's Witness
